The Metro East Chapter Charity Committee is proud to announce the third charity we will focus on for the 2009 fundraising year. During the months of July and August, we will collect donations for Project **Education for Homeless Students and Youth.**

According to the National Coalition for the Homeless, 1.35 million U.S. children are homeless on any given night and families are now the fastest growing segment of the homeless population, accounting for almost 39 percent of the nation's homeless.

Who is a "Homeless" Student? The term "homeless child and youth" means those who lack a fixed, regular and adequate nighttime residence. This includes those living in shelters, motels, cars, parks, abandoned buildings, substandard housing or sharing the housing of others due to a loss of housing, such as a natural disaster resulting in the temporary or permanent loss of their home. (i.e. fire, hurricane, tornado, etc.)

Although this program provides various aspects of assistance, we will be concentrating on school supplies. personal hygiene items and cash donations. Cash donations will be converted into gift cards and distributed by the school district to the children and families in need. These donations will be distributed to schools within the Macomb County District which currently has 614 homeless or displaced students, including students who were displaced due to Hurricane Katrina.
