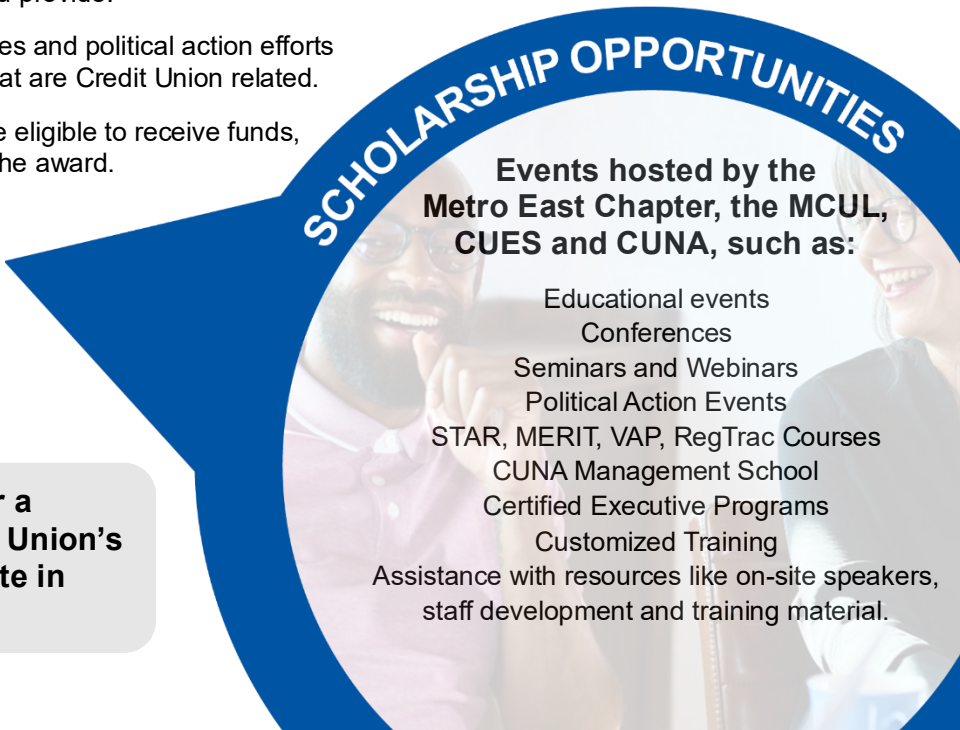
Eligibility:
